Whether it is to create the clothing or textiles that protect us from the elements or to furnish and insulate our living spaces the craft of weaving is common to all human societies and cultures.

NAGA is an expression in its most elemental form of the warp, using pure wool FELT to plait a combination of three chromatic tones to give depth and texture to this collection of rugs designed by **GAN**, a company dedicated to the search for optimum craft techniques from around the globe.

Its motif is a celebration of the plaited felt technique, 100% pure new wool in an eternal pattern that crosses cultural boundaries and fashion predilections.

NAGA is available in turquoise and blue colour choices, there are two sizes 170 x 240 cm and 200 x 300 cm.
