

ALDEN One Piece Elongate Watercloset

4. Once watercloset (11) is set in place, the threading of the T-Bolts (not supplied) will be protruding through the slots. Place the washers (not supplied) and then thread the nuts (not supplied) onto T-Bolts.

CAUTION: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN NUTS AS IT MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO WATERCLOSET.

5. Place bolt caps (16) over the hardware, T-Bolts may need to be cut to fit caps.

FLUSH LEVER INSTALLATION:

- IMPORTANT: The Flush Lever is packaged separately from the Watercloset and is provided with detailed Installation Guidelines.
- 6. Follow the Installation Guidelines provided with the Flush Lever (**Style No. 100555**) to properly install the Lever.

SUPPLY WATER INSTALLATION:

> See Figure - 02 for Steps 7 - 10.



- 7. Install Waterworks Inlet Supply Valve (sold separately) on house water supply and remove supply pipe that comes with the supply valve. Make sure water is off at this point.
- 8. Unthread fill valve inlet nut (15) and discard spacer (14) and rubber cone washer (13). Place speedi inlet tube through fill valve inlet nut and re-thread to bottom of fill valve. This is to be hand tight, DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.
- 9. Reconnect speedi inlet pipe to the inlet supply valve, pipe may need to be cut or bent.
- 10. Make sure that all connections are tight, but not overtight, and turn on supply water. Once the watercloset tank is full, flush the lever several times and check for leaks.
- 11. Install tank lid (1) after completing these steps.

MOLDED WOOD SEAT INSTALLATION: ALWCO1

12. Place threaded studs of the wood molded seat (17) through the holes on the rim of watercloset (11) and fasten








- 13. Align plastic seat (22) over the rim of the watercloset (11). Place oval flat metal washers (21) into hinge hardware case. Make sure that washers are positioned so the seat is properly aligned.
- 14. Insert plastic screws (20) through the washer (21) and through the watercloset (11). Thread on the plastic nuts (23) on the underside of the rim and use a screw driver to tighten. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.
- 15. Close the latches on the hinge hardware case to complete this installation.

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



1. Remove the RETAINING NUT, METAL WASHER, and RUBBER WASHER from the FLUSH LEVER SHANK.







2. Insert the FLAT ROD through the hole on the WATERCLOSET making sure the BENT END of the ROD is orientated towards the BOTTOM.


NOTE: The back of the HANDLE is square shape so it fits properly in mounting hole.



 Using the CLIP provided with the FLUSH VALVE, connect the PULL CHAIN to one of the holes on the FLAT ROD. Adjust the CHAIN length and/or its position on the FLAT ROD to ensure the FLUSH VALVE is lifted when the HANDLE is rotated.



3. Re-install the RUBBER WASHER, METAL WASHER, and RETAINING NUT making sure to securely tighten the NUT.



4. Rotate the HANDLE forwards and backwards to ensure the ROD rotates freely and is not obstructed by anything include the FILL VALVE.

NOTE: The ROD should **NOT** be obstructed by anything including the FILL VALVE.
